National report of Croatia for the period January 2024 – January 2025		
A	Summary <i>A short summary, which describes main points of the national report. This part is also usually sent in a separate document before the national report.</i>	This National report will present activities in the field of standardization of geographical names in the Republic of Croatia in 2024. The Commission for the Standardization of Geographical Names (the Commission) in 2024 held twelve meetings and worked continuously, through its working groups, on three documents (naming settlements, streets, squares and other public areas, version 2.0; naming relief forms; naming inland waters and seas) for the purpose of quality assurance of the Register of Geographical Names and in order to spread awareness about the topic of geographical names. By applying the Law on Settlements and Law on State Survey and Real Estate Cadastre in 2024 the Commission produced 61 Opinions and 1 Recommendation on proposal for naming streets and squares and other geographic objects in certain local self-government units and, consequently, standardized 185 geographical names. The information system of the Register of Geographical Names (website and network application) has been updated and new functionalities have been added. Online services for viewing and downloading data from system database are available to public users. Activities of the revision of geographical names records in the Register of Geographical Names, which began at the end of 2023, have been continued in 2024 on a new data set. Adopted decision on the entry into force of the "Act on Amendments to the Law on State Survey and Real Estate Register" which regulates the Register of geographical names. The Commission continuously gives its expert opinions to the users / interested public, related to the suggestions for naming and/or changing the geographical names of geographical objects in the Republic of Croatia.
B	Member state report on the situation in their country <i>The progress made in the standardization of geographical names since the last UNGEGN session (news in the field of geonames in the country, progress of ongoing projects, finished projects, issues and use cases for inspiration for other countries, changes in database of geonames).</i>	January 2024 – December 2024: By applying the Law on Settlements and Law on State Survey and Real Estate Cadastre in 2024 the Commission produced 61 Opinions and 1 Recommendation on proposal for naming streets and squares and other geographic objects in certain local self-government units and, consequently, standardized 185 geographical names. January 2024 – December 2024: Activities of the revision of geographical names records in the Register of Geographical Names, which began at the end of 2023, have been continued in 2024, so that geographical names for 22,5% of the whole Croatian territory have been revised and standardized by a team of experts in the fields of geography, cartography and the Croatian language.

At the end of the year, preparations began for the revision of the next, new, data set.
Eb	Office treatment of names	January 2024 - December 2024 – the Commission continuously gives its expert opinions to the users/interested public, related to the suggestions for naming and/or changing the geographical names of geographical objects in the Republic of Croatia.

Experts for the following languages are included: Italian, Serbian, Slovak, Albanian, Hungarian and Czech.
